(d) Ten (10) scholarships were given to Vietnamese children demonstrating proven academic ability.

(e) Through the manufacture of concrete well rings in the Battalion sponsered brickyard, two new wells were conpleted by the local populace and three old wells improved to include the installation of two manual pumps on recently covered wells.

(f) Routine support was given small building projects through distribution of salvaged building materials.

(g) The Battalion assumed the responsibility for two new hamlets, An Ngai Dong and Tung Son in the village of Hoa Thanh and was relieved of its responsibility for the hamlet of Hunng Phuoc in the village of Hoa Vinh.
